Stop Illegal Dumping

Illegal dumping is disposal of waste in an un-permitted area.

Illegally dumped wastes are primarily non-hazardous materials that are

dumped to avoid either disposal fees or the time and effort required for proper disposal. Many health risks are associated with illegal dumpsites and they are a serious problem.



First Offense = \$50 - \$250.00 Fine
Second Offense = \$100 - \$500 Fine

Rubbish Pick-Up

Jackson County Solid Waste Department

The County will pick up large items at (County) **residential properties** that can not be put in the proper format for the waste haulers to take.



Limitations

(Effective as of 9/8/00 Ordinance)

- The maximum volume of trash, trees, debris and/or vegetation that Jackson County may remove per pickup day is three (3) cubic yards.
- Jackson County hereby ceases the pickup of trash, trees, debris and/or vegetation that is the result of having been cleared off a vacant lot or vacant lots.
- Jackson County hereby ceases the pickup of trash, trees, debris and/or vegetation that is the result of a structure of structures being built and/or renovated.
- In the event trash, trees, debris and/or vegetation is placed in the street, roadway, or highway, said material will be placed back onto the property from which it came and will not be taken away by the County.
- The Ordinance shall not be in effect as to emergency situations declared by the Jackson County Board of Supervisors.

The County is very limited in manpower and vehicles, having only one worker and one truck for each of the three areas, therefore **residents are encouraged to use the landfills** whenever possible -- **especially during the dry spells in an effort to prevent fire hazards.**

Unincorporated Residents may also use Talleys and Applewhite Landfills **FREE of CHARGE** (see back)

- White Goods (motors removed)
- Plastic

With Restrictions:

- Tires
- Cut/shredded tires
- Batteries
- Refrigerators
