

# Pascagoula River Audubon Bridge

Dantzler Street, Moss Point  
Tidelands (DMR), and GOMESA Grant Funding

This project consists of replacing an existing bridge across Rhodes Bayou just upstream from the National Audubon Society. The project will support the operations of the Pascagoula River Audubon Center's mission of promoting education regarding the conservation of the Pascagoula River. The newer, higher elevation bridge will allow sufficient clearance for guided boat tours of the Pascagoula River and connecting waterways, as well as the safe passage of other low profile vessels. The new bridge will also provide a wider sidewalk affording safer pedestrian traffic and navigational lighting providing safer nautical night time navigation.
