The LaPointe-Krebs House Rehabilitation is an ongoing restoration project made possible in part by a grant from the Mississippi Gulf Coast National Heritage Area. This grant will assist with the cost of the installation of a wood shake roof and chimney repair which will protect the structure and work completed to date. Dating back to the 18th century, the house has suffered damage and deterioration from termites and Hurricane Katrina. Once fully restored, this important piece of Jackson County history will once again be open to the public as a tourist and educational destination for those interested in history, architecture, and local traditions.
