

# La-Pointe Krebs House

4602 Fort Street, Pascagoula  
Community Heritage Preservation Grant

Through funds provided by the Mississippi Department of Archives and History this multi-phased project includes the rehabilitation of possibly the oldest structure of its kind in the Mississippi valley. Dating back to the 18<sup>th</sup> century the house has suffered damage and deterioration from termites and Hurricane Katrina. The purpose of this project is not only to properly stabilize the house, but due to its importance in history, to rehabilitate it through repair and restoration preserving the integrity of its original character. This unique house is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is designated a Mississippi Landmark.
