This project was funded through the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency (M.E.M.A.) and administered by Jackson County Grant Department following Hurricane Katrina to assist in the renovation and upgrade of the pre-existing community center. Meeting FEMA 361 performance standards to withstand hurricane force winds of up to 200 mph, the community center now serves as a shelter during natural disasters accommodating up to 250 occupants.
