


**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI**

The Board of Supervisors of Jackson County, Mississippi, will have an emergency meeting, pursuant to Title 19, Chapter 3, Section 19(3) of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, on Friday, March 27, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room at 2915 Canty Street, Pascagoula, Mississippi. The Federal Government, the State of Mississippi, and Jackson County, Mississippi have all declared states of emergency due to the possibility of epidemic conditions as a result of the corona virus. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the current status of the county and what additional actions the Board of Supervisors may need to take concerning county operations, employees, policies, and other matters affecting the county during this state of emergency and to take such actions as deemed appropriate. Such matters will include, but not be limited to, an amendment to the Jackson County Health care plan regarding the corona virus, contracting to monitor beaches and other public areas, and additional actions needed, if any.

This meeting will also be broadcast via live stream on Jackson County, Mississippi's Facebook page. Unless required to physically attend said meeting, you are encouraged to view the live stream.


